


## Blackstone / GSO Loan Financing Limited ("BGLF")

- Objective
  BGLF's (the "Company") investment objective is to provide shareholders with stable and growing income returns, and to grow the capital value of its investment portfolio by exposure predominantly to European and US floating rate senior secured loans, both directly and indirectly. The Company achieves its investment objective solely through its investment in Blackstone / GSO Corporate Funding ("BGCF")<sup>1</sup>, which is an investor in global floating rate senior secured loans.
- BGCF funds its investment in European and US loans using a variety of funding sources, including equity capital, its 3-year syndicated financing facility, notes issued to the Company, and non-recourse leverage obtained from retaining Income Notes in collateralised loan obligations ("CLOs") that BGCF has established.

#### Monthly Commentary

- The Company's total NAV return was 0.52% in January. This month's total return for the direct investment in loans was 0.08%, comprised of 0.12% income after leverage costs and -0.04% in MTM movement. The total return across the European and US CLO investments was 0.54%, comprised of 0.82% income and -0.28% net portfolio movement. The Company's share price return for January was -0.25%.<sup>7,8</sup>
- For the month of January, U.S. loans and high yield returned 1.08% and 0.60%, respectively, and European loans and high yield returned 0.66% and 0.17%, respectively.<sup>7</sup>
- Loan new issue volumes were strong at the start of the year in both the U.S. and Europe, with \$46.8 billion of issuance in the U.S. and €15.2 billion in Europe compared to \$35.3 billion in the U.S. and €4.4 billion in Europe in December. The use of proceeds for the loans in both the U.S. and Europe were primarily for M&A related activities with 51% and 75%, in the markets, respectively.<sup>8</sup>
- January CLO new issuance volume was subdued in both the U.S. and Europe with \$6.3 billion / 10 CLOs and €0.7 billion / two CLOs recorded in each market, respectively. However, CLO refinancing and reset activity increased globally. During the month, \$14.6 billion of U.S. CLO tranches and €1.8 billion of European CLO tranches were refinanced or reset. Continued demand for CLO paper resulted in tighter spreads for CLO liabilities, as new issue post-crisis CLO AAA levels narrowed to 100bp in the U.S. and 70bp in Europe.<sup>8</sup>
- On 12 January, Tymon Park CLO DAC was refinanced resulting in a reduction in the cost of liabilities of 94bp and a WAL test extension of 15 months. In addition, BGCF, through its U.S. Majority Owned Affiliate ("U.S. MOA"), purchased the Income Notes of Stewart Park CLO Ltd, a U.S. CLO that was reset on 16 January. The U.S. MOA also committed to purchase 59.1% of the Income Notes of Greenwood Park CLO Ltd ("Greenwood Park") (\$1.07 billion), which priced on 29 January and is expected to close on 6 March.
- Year to date, BGCF EUR has called €82 million of capital, which will be invested in BGCF by 1 March, resulting in €81.3 million of undrawn capital.
- On 9 February, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit ruled in favour of the LSTA in its lawsuit against the SEC and the Federal Reserve, determining that U.S. CLO managers are not subject to the risk retention rules per the Dodd-Frank Act as it applies to "open market CLOS". There is a period of 45-days during which the ruling may be appealed. This ruling does not impact the risk retention rules for European CLO managers.


